

Miraj Mahavidyalaya Miraj Student Satisfaction Survey 2022-23

The Internal Quality Assurance cell conducted an online student Satisfaction survey for the academic year 2022-23. A questionnaire comprising of 21 multiple choice questions was circulated among the students and data is collected from 1329 student given responses out of 563. The student's satisfaction survey is analyzed and also discussed in the meeting of the IQAC. The response to this survey is 42%.

The survey analysis revealed the following points.

- 1. Approximately 95% Teachers clearly defines the course objective to students at the beginning.
- 2. Approximately 94% Teachers stimulate intellectual curiosity and the desire to learn.
- 3. Teachers have good ability to communicate with the students. It also reflects good teaching quality of the faculty members. Overall, 94% Teachers have good teaching quality.
- 4. Teachers adopt various student centric methods of teaching including experiential as well as participative learning. Teachers also use problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experience response is 90%.
- 5. About 93% of the objectives completed by Teachers, established in the Syllabus.
- 6. Teachers always promote classroom participation of students with their Skillful and demonstrative illustration. Response is 92.7%.
- 7. Approximately 95% Teachers have answered questions and problems raised during class.
- 8. Approximately 91% Teachers use ICT tools while teaching in the class.
- 9. Teachers are always available for solving the questions and doubts, outside the classroom Response is 91 %.
- 10. Approximately 97 % of the syllabus was completed by Teachers during the academic year.
- 11. Teachers prepare well prior to teaching to their respective classes.
- 12. Teachers have good ability to communicate within the students. It also replaces good teaching quality of the faculty members.
- 13. Students are quite satisfied by Teacher's approach towards teaching.



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- 14. The internal evaluation system made by Teacher is quite fair.
- 15. Teacher and Institute take active interest in promoting life skills, soft skills and employability skills among students. This has been made possible mainly by Placement Cell of Institute.
- 16. The teaching and mentoring process of our institute assist to develop and enhance the cognitive, social and emotional growth of students.
- 17. The institute provides multiple opportunities to the learners in terms of wide academic flexibility and motivation of the students, to words competitive examinations, science-exhibition, different cultural programs, Avishkar competition.
- 18.Mentor takes regular follow up of mentors in solving their problems with an assigned task.
- 19. Teacher identified the student strength and encourages the students with providing right level of challenges by taking different of efforts.
- 20. Teachers are able to identify the weaknesses of the students and help them to overcome the problems and difficulties arise during the teaching- learning process.




5. What degree program are you pursuing now?








2.Did the Teacher Stimulate my intellectual curiosity and my desire to learn? 563 responses




3. Was the the teacher clear on explaining the subject and her /his class was well organised?




4.Did the teachers use methodologies that actively engaged students in the learning process?




5.Did the teacher make possible achieving the learning objectives established in the syllabus?








8.What percentage of teachers use ICT tools while teaching?




9. Was teacher available for questions outside class hours?


10. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




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11. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

12. How well did the teachers able to communicate? ?







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13. The teachers approach to teaching can best be describe as

14. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.









