Anti-Ragging Committee: As per the UGC and university regulations, various committees of the staff have been formed to observe discipline and to ensure a safe and healthy work environment to every individual of the college. Also, the college publishes its regulations in prospectus stating that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC notifications regarding the regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging.
